- For the 20 Hours General English, students will initially be placed into Timetable A classes. However, in the case of high class sizes, students might be placed into Timetable B.  
*Please note that students will be assigned to each timetable based on availability, and they won't be able to request their preferred timetable.*
- Students have the option of either 20hrs per week or an integrated 20hrs + 5hrs self-study.
- For the self-study option, the first access code for the online materials is free. Any subsequent code (if a student moves up a level) will cost an additional \$20.
- There will be a variety of options for students to supplement their language instruction with monthly electives and social English groups being offered.
- For both LSNZ Queenstown and Christchurch, only Timetable A for 20hrs and 25 hrs will be available on the 8th January, 2024.
- The curriculum that we follow at the school is EVOLVE, published by Cambridge (for conversation classes), and English File, published by Oxford (for grammar and self-study).
